




SPECIAL PROJECTS COMMITTEE: A COMMITMENT TO TRANSPARENCY AND COLLABORATION

SPECIAL PROJECTS COMMITTEE FOR CAMPUS RENOVATION

Since 2017 Christ Church Cranbrook has embarked on a bold strategy to enhance and expand its campus to better fulfill its mission of meeting Jesus, finding Joy, sharing Beauty, and serving others. The need to increase multipurpose space, classrooms and meeting space were identified as paramount objectives of the renovation plan.

In early 2019, the Vestry approved engagement in a capital campaign as a first step in realizing this vision. As of September 2019, \$8.5 million in pledges and \$2.1 million in planned giving gifts were committed to the project.

In November 2019, the Vestry appointed the Special Project Committee (SPC), which has been tasked with managing the campus renovation. The SPC brought together representation from a range of existing committees and ministries that play an integral role in the project (see diagram to the right). The scope of the campus expansion project is significant, and the SPC is committed to being facilitative, inclusive and transparent in its work.

The SPC will offer opportunities and venues for ongoing dialogue and open forums to invite the congregation to stay informed of our progress and provide feedback throughout the duration of the project.
